




INVESTIGATION & REMEDIATION

 - What is the damage to the bank?

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Step 2: Reporting – statement of facts and recommendations

- Presentation of the facts of the case
- Recommendations to remedy the detected shortcomings and weaknesses

Step 3: Remediation - implementation of the measures

- Remediation of the 'non-compliance' state
- Implementation of measures to avoid future risks
